Old Business:

Raffle ticket update: Dave Deiss – Checked on a UTV at M & M in Pine Island and a motion was made by Dwight Smith and Phil Deiss to move forward on the purchase of the UTV for 18,045 and a profit of 11,500.00 after the expenses of the raffle.

Scavenger Hunt update: Wendy Smith-There is a change this year from a picture booklet to a card that will be stamped after you successfully find a matchbox size UTV at one of the locations (about thirty locations) The cards will cost 5.00 each. The business locations that participate in hiding the matchbox UTV will receive twenty cards to sell to their customers, and they will pay a fee of 100.00 to participate this year. It will start on June 1<sup>st</sup> and end on September 20<sup>th</sup>. The winners will be announced at our October meeting.
